## Fryelands Teacher Wins Prestigious Golden Apple Award

**Monroe**, **WA** – Randy Brow n, a third grade teacher at Fryelands Elementary School is this year's w inner of the Stanley O. McNaughton Golden Apple Aw ard for Excellence in Education. Brow n is an early adopter of the "flipped classroom" model of teaching, w hich uses instructional videos made by the teacher.

Brow n grew up in Spokane, and has been teaching for 30 years. "When Isaw my very first Kahn Academy video, sitting in a parking lot, on my phone, it blew me away," he said of his first experience with video instruction.

Brow n w as immediately inspired to learn how to create instructional videos. In 2012, after months of planning and recording videos, he put them to w ork in his classroom, show ing the videos to a small group of students, then w orking w ith them on their lessons w hile the next group w atches the video.

Jerry Martin, w hose daughter Emma w as in Brow n's class last year, has nothing but good things to say about Brow n. "The flipped classroom he does is absolutely amazing. It's as if there are two of him in the classroom: the group watching him recorded previously, and him live in the classroom for those that aren't watching the video. It really frees him up."

Brow n also teaches a summer class for other educators on how to make instructional videos for their classes. He teaches that class flipped as well, so the teachers can experience what it feels like, and he already has other educators following his lead.

Brow n admits that creating all the videos for his flipped classroom took all of his spare evenings and w eekends to put together. "I really recommend people start w ith flipping just *one* subject a year." Many of Brow n's videos, as well as student-created videos can be seen on his website, www.mrrbrown.org.

This year's aw ard w inners will be honored at a ceremony to be held at Seattle Repertory Theatre in Seattle on January 17, 2014 at 7:00 pm. The Golden Apple Aw ards ceremony will air in primetime on public television stations statewide in February 2014.
